Summer Day Camp for Ages 4&5

Camp is filling fast, but we have room for more Peepers and Tadpoles (ages 4&5) who will delight in getting to know the farm animals, exploring the gardens and surrounding forests, and making new friends. Structured activity and well-supervised free exploration are carefully balanced to provide a fun and welcoming early experience on the farm. Camp runs weekly, Mon-Fri, Jul. 6 through Aug. 14.
