**STONEWALL FARM:** Stonewall Farm is a non-profit educational Farm in Keene, NH. We host students year round, including summer camp, which takes place on our 120+ acres of farm, field, forest, and wetland. Our summer camp provides farm based, experiential learning for children aged 3-17.

**JOB DESCRIPTION:** Summer educators are responsible for planning and implementing experiential learning activities for campers aged 3-14 with a co-educator. Some activities may include hiking, farm chores, gardening, nature-based crafts, traditional camp games and songs, caring for farm animals, and more.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Planning an age-appropriate weekly camp schedule
  - Lead a group of children in camp activities around the farm
  - Create a safe, fun, and nurturing environment for all campers
  - Assist in daily set up and clean-up of camp activities
  - Facilitate weekly family nights for parents and campers
  - Provide overnight supervision to campers approximately 2 times during the summer
  - Provide before and after care services on a rotating basis

- Ability to work outdoors with plants and animals

- Ability to work with minimal supervision
- Certification/ willingness to become certified in CPR and First Aid
- Must be able to lift 50 pounds
- Must be 18 years or older at time of hire
